TNRD Landfill or Transfer Station Hours of Operation – Closest to Barriere

All sites closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day

- Agate Bay Transfer Station for Barriere Landfill
At the 22 km mark of the Adams Lake Road, just north of the Agate Bay Road junction.

Summer hours in effect: March 1 - October 31, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Winter hours in effect November 1 - February 28: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

- Barriere Landfill
Approx. 8 km east of Barriere on East Barriere Lake Road (1500 Barriere Lakes Road)

- McLure Transfer Station
Directly across from the Fish Trap Rapids rest stop on Highway #5 (2076 Yellowhead Highway South)

Summer hours in effect Mar 1 to Oct 31: 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday

Winter hours in effect Nov 1 to Feb 28: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday

- Simpcw (Chu Chua) Transfer Station for Barriere Landfill
About 3 kms south of the North Thompson Indian Band office on Dunn Lake Road, north of Barriere

Waste Removal & Disposal
