All sites closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day

- 70 Mile House Transfer Station for Cache Creek Landfill
Approx. 8 km east of 70 Mile House on Green Lake Road - Site is about 500 Meters north of Green Lake Road on a gravel access road (3061 North Bonaparte Road)
- Clinton Transfer Station for Cache Creek Landfill
1 km south of Clinton on Highway 97 and 1 km west into site (5 Boyd Pit Road)

Summer hours in effect March 1 to October 31: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Winter hours in effect November 1 to February 28: 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday
