TNRD Landfill or Transfer Station Hours of Operation – Close to Sun Peaks

All sites closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day

- Heffley Creek Landfill
7 km east of Highway 5 on Todd (Sun Peaks) Mountain Road, then 700 meters into the site (7381 Sullivan Valley Road)

Summer hours in effect Mar 1 to Oct 31: 7:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday, Tuesday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Winter hours in effect Nov 1 to Feb 28: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday

- Sun Peaks Mountain Resort area Transfer Station for Heffley Creek Landfill
Approx. 30 kms east of Highway 5 on Tod Mountain Road (Sun Peaks Road) (1320 Industrial Way), from SP, first right after Burfield Chair

Summer hours in effect Mar 1 to Oct 31: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, Sunday

Winter hours in effect Nov 1 to Feb 28: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Note:

- Paint may be dropped off at most paint supply stores.
- Oil containers may be dropped off at most oil change places.
- Used motor oil may be dropped off at any gas station.
- Used batteries may be dropped off at most battery supply stores.
